We have indoor washroom facilities with a large viewing room for the kids to get out of the sun.

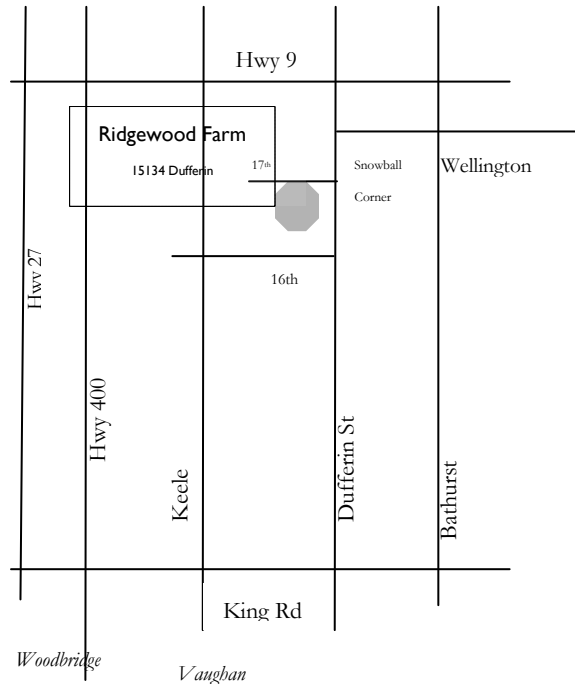
Our stable has 36 box stalls and various individual and group paddocks. We offer full boarding, training and coaching for the casual or show rider.

## COSTS:

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5 Day Session: \$ 384.20 inc taxes

4 Day Session: \$ 307.36

Helmet Rental: \$20.00 per session

Campers that have their own helmets must meet the current safety standards.

A current dated cheque or cash for the full amount, along with completed registration form will secure a session.

Registration will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Please note that there is a minimum of 4 campers to run a session.

A \$50.00 fee will be charged for all cheques that are returned from the bank for any reason.
